

# MyChart COVID Results for Proxy View

Any proxy for patients ages 13-17 will now be able to see the last 5 COVID-19 test results via MyChart.

## Viewing COVID Results for MyChart Proxy

These steps apply to both the MyChart Mobile app as well as the MyChart Website.

1. If the Proxy opens the patient's MyChart, the *COVID-19 Test Results* section appears in the Menu.
2. Clicking the section title will open the screen to display the 5 most recent results.

If COVID-19 is still suspected, based on exposure history together with other clinical findings, re-testing should be considered in consultation with public health authorities. Laboratory test results should always be considered in the context of clinical observations and epidemiological data in making a final diagnosis and patient management decisions.*
